

#### Mason Jar Sweet Potato Ground Turkey Scramble

#### **Ingredients:**

1 pound ground turkey 1/4 teaspoon salt 1 leek, sliced thinly 2 sweet potatoes 1/2 teaspoon cardamom 7 large eggs

1/4 teaspoon cinnamon mushrooms: roughly 28 slices







\*\*optional: green onions to garnish

Instructions: 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. 2. Place ground turkey into a medium skillet & add the leeks, then cook over medium-high heat until the meat is browned and the leeks are soft and transparent. Drain any excess grease. 3. Add the cardamom, cinnamon, and salt. 4. Roast the sweet potatoes in the oven at 400 degrees for 35-40 minutes or use a knife to spear small slits in the sweet potatoes & microwave for 7-8 minutes, until softened. 5. Remove the sweet potatoes from the oven or microwave, and slice open. Let cool slightly. 6. Crack the eggs in a medium bowl & whisk until the yolks & whites are well combined. 7. Grab 7 half pint sized (8oz) mason jars, then begin to layer the components. First add a large spoonful of sweet potato to the bottom, flattening the mash out so it's spread evenly. Next, add 3 heaping spoonfuls of ground turkey, packing slightly. 8. Use a 1/4 measuring cup to scoop out a 1/4 cup of the eggs & pour into the mason jars, then top with 4 sliced mushrooms, covering the egg completely. 9. Add another spoonful of mashed sweet potatoes to top & flatten slightly. 10. Place mason jars in the oven on a sturdy baking sheet (to avoid any spills) & bake for 20-25 minutes, until the egg is fully cooked. 11. Let cool, screw tops on the mason jars & store in frig if desired. When ready to eat, remove lid & microwave for 1-2 minutes until warmed throughout.
